

Charter for the HHFMA Payment and Reimbursement Committee

Mission:

To identify, research and study emerging home care and hospice payment and reimbursement issues to assist HHFMA and NAHC in the development of strategy, advocacy, and education on the corresponding payment and reimbursement issues.

Role:

The Payment and Reimbursement Committee will conduct business through quarterly teleconference meetings to help identify emerging home care and hospice payment and reimbursement matters that the HHFMA Workgroup should address on behalf of HHFMA and NAHC. Where appropriate, temporary subcommittees or task forces will be established to focus on payment and reimbursement issues that have been identified as needing attention. Such subcommittees or task forces shall work with the Payment and Reimbursement Committee to develop the goals, appropriate forum for meetings, and timeline for desired results.

It is intended that the Payment and Reimbursement Committee leverage the experience, expertise, and insight of subject matter experts to build workgroups to research and study home care and hospice payment and reimbursement issues to assist HHFMA and NAHC in the development of strategy, advocacy, and education on the corresponding payment and reimbursement issues.

Purpose:

Review on a quarterly basis current initiatives of the Payment and Reimbursement Committee and identify new and emerging payment and reimbursement matters that the committee should address. The committee will:

- Help identify and determine the appropriate payment and reimbursement matters to be addressed by HHFMA
- Where necessary, create subcommittees/task forces of subject matter experts to research and study identified issues
- Help develop the strategic, advocacy, and educational direction on the identified issues
- Work in tandem with the other HHFMA committees (i.e., Education, Policy, Business Analytics, Communication) to accomplish the desired goals of the committee

Membership:

Chair of the Payment and Reimbursement Committee will be a current member of the HHFMA Advisory Board. Chairs of any subcommittees/tasks forces formed on behalf of the Payment and Reimbursement Committee will be a current member of the HHFMA Workgroup. All other members of the committee and subcommittee/tasks forces shall be in good standing of HHFMA.

Members should be interested in payment and reimbursement matters affecting all aspects of home care and hospice and shall have experience with such matters.

Expectations of the Payment and Reimbursement Committee members:

- Participate in at least 50% of the quarterly conference calls (2) of the committee
- Willing to work on projects, initiatives, subcommittees outside of the conference calls based on the planning agenda of the committee
